# Mississippi

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, in partnership with ASCD, developed the Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child (WSCC) framework to highlight the need for schools to address all aspects of children's physical, mental, and social well-being to help them learn and thrive. As part of the Together for Healthy and Successful Schools Initiative funded by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, Child Trends, the Institute for Health Research and Policy at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC), and EMT Associates, Inc., <u>analyzed state statutes and regulations</u> for key topic areas across the WSCC's 10 components. To understand whether and how local education agencies (LEAs) implement and/or extend state policy around the WSCC, UIC analyzed district board policies, regulations, codes of conduct, and student handbooks from a representative, random sample of districts in 19 states and the District of Columbia.

This profile highlights the extent to which 21 public school districts in Mississippi have policies that cover topic areas across the WSCC. The public school district data are weighted to be representative of public school districts in the state. Please note, because of the small number of charter LEAs sampled, they are not included in this profile.
