WHAT


AccessMatters has managed the Health Resource Center Program in Philadelphia since 1991, with the first centers opening in 1992. In 2015, the Pennsylvania Department of Health expanded the Health Resource Center Program across the state of Pennsylvania. AccessMatters' Health Resource Center Program supports school- and community-based spaces that provide sexual health education, counseling, and related services.

WHY

This program was created to promote adolescent sexual and reproductive health in Pennsylvania by increasing access to services in 11 designated counties across the state.



Zip codes in Philadelphia with Health Resource Centers report significantly greater than average improvements in sexual and reproductive health outcomes than Philadelphia zip codes without Health Resource Centers:
